- For this presentation you will give directions

- Create a map illustrating your route so you can remember your steps (DO NOT write the directions on the map, however, as you must memorize directions.)
- Map will be graded separately (5 points)
- Use words in Spanish, with the exception of Proper nouns (e.g. “la calle Scott”)
- Remember the placement of nouns and adjectives
