- The purpose of this assignment is to help you master a grammar concept in Spanish by teaching your classmates about it.
- You will create a “station” for students to visit during our Study Group time this week and next.
- Teach your classmates whatever grammar topic your group chose.
- Make it entertaining if possible (Games, quizzes, lessons).
- Your presentation should be about 3 minutes in length.
- Be sure you allow time for the people visiting your station to have the opportunity to practice what you have taught them. This should take an additional minute.

Pronunciation	Often mumbles cannot be understood. Mispronounces 50% of words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly most of the time. Mispronounces less than half the words.	Speaks clearly and distinctly all of the time and mispronounces few or no words
Vocabulary	Vocabulary is limited. Uses only the minimum required vocabulary and little extra.	Uses some appropriate vocabulary learned in class and includes some extra vocabulary.	Uses appropriate vocabulary learned in class and includes extra vocabulary well.
Organization	Presentation does not show sequence or structure	Presentation shows sequence and structure most of the time.	Presentation shows sequence and structure all of the time.
Creativity	The skit shows minimum effort. The skit lacks creativity.	The skit shows adequate to good effort and has creativity.	The skit shows superior effort and creativity.

Writing	Errors interfere with meaning. Grammar usage, sentence structure and spelling contain many errors.	Some errors sometimes interfere with meaning. Only minor errors are evident in final script, grammar usage, sentence structure and spelling.	Few or no errors, not interfering with meaning. The use of writing conventions is fluid and complex: Spelling, punctuation, grammar usage, sentence structure.
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
